#### Who can use School Visitor check-in

• Visitors such as parents and carers, contractors, service providers and volunteers.

Students or visitors under the age of 18 are not required to use School Visitor Check-in.

School Visitor Check-in will be ready from 18 October at all NSW Government schools.

#### **History Competition**

Earlier this semester Larshya Sutharsamohan competed in the National History Competition, a 45-minute test with 50 multiple choice questions that require the use of historical sources to answer. Nationwide 7,745 students sat the exam with 4,191 of those coming from New South Wales. Larshya did extremely well in what was a difficult exam and received a distinction. Her overall mark was 84; 18 above the state mean and 17 above the national mean.

#### **Stage 5 TAFE Automotive**

This week a group of Year 9 & 10 students headed to Deniliquin TAFE to start their 8 week Stage 5 Cert 1 Automotive course. The students involved will spend 2 days per week over the coming 8 weeks attending both practical and theoretical automotive classes at the TAFE. This is a great opportunity for our students to get a taste of the adult learning environment encompassed by TAFE, learn some automotive skills and knowledge and to reinvigorate their interest in learning.
